import psycopg2

uname = "dbices"
pwd   = "vectors"
host  = "postgresx03.infra.xtr.deltares.nl"
dbname= "ICES"

# function that gets the data from a database using connection strings and a string with a SQL command.
def getdata(dbname,host,uname,pwd,strSql):
    conn = psycopg2.connect("dbname="+dbname+" host="+host+" user="+uname+" password="+pwd)

    cur = conn.cursor()
    arr = []

    cur.execute(strSql)
    arr = cur.fetchall()

    conn.close()

    return arr
