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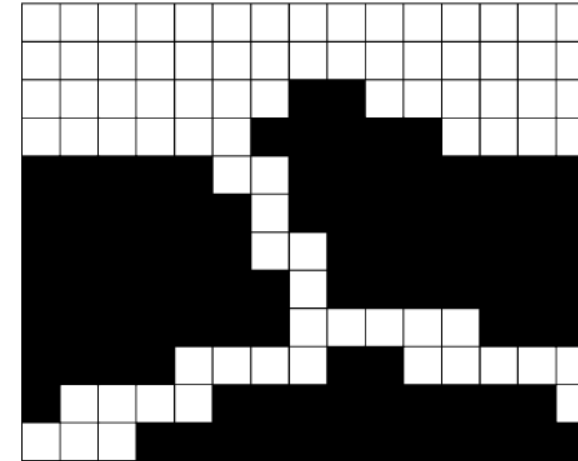

## How to get the flux right through a narrow sound?

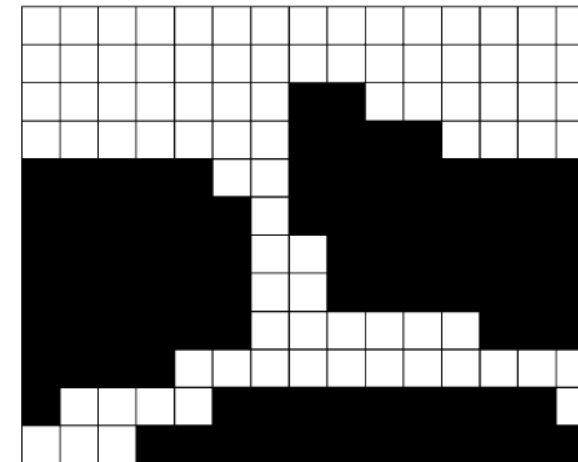
Too low flux through Saltstraumen:

### 1. Modify the topography

The channel is aligned with the grid:  
- Flux is more in accordance with measurements



(a) First interpretation



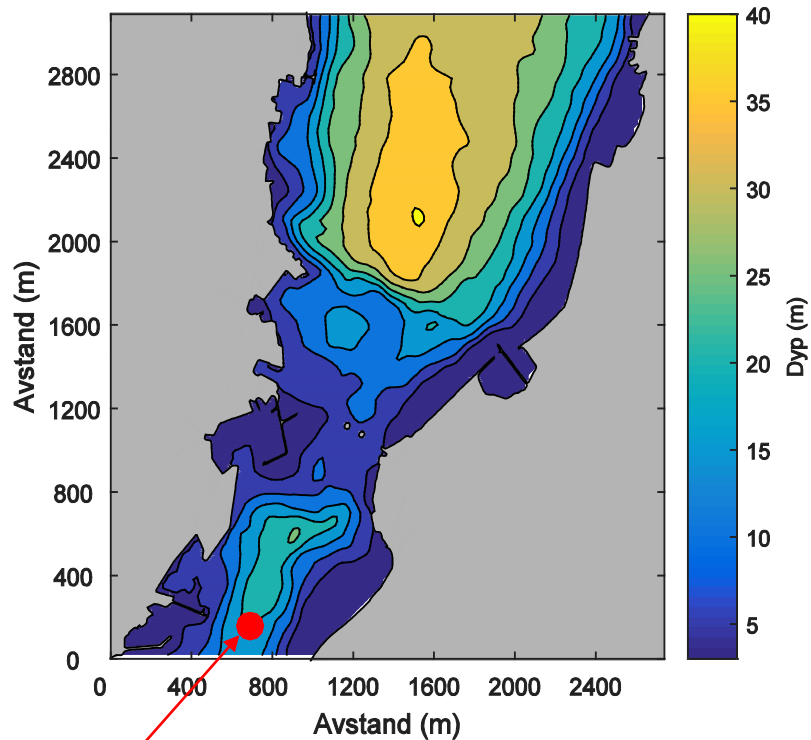
(b) Second interpretation

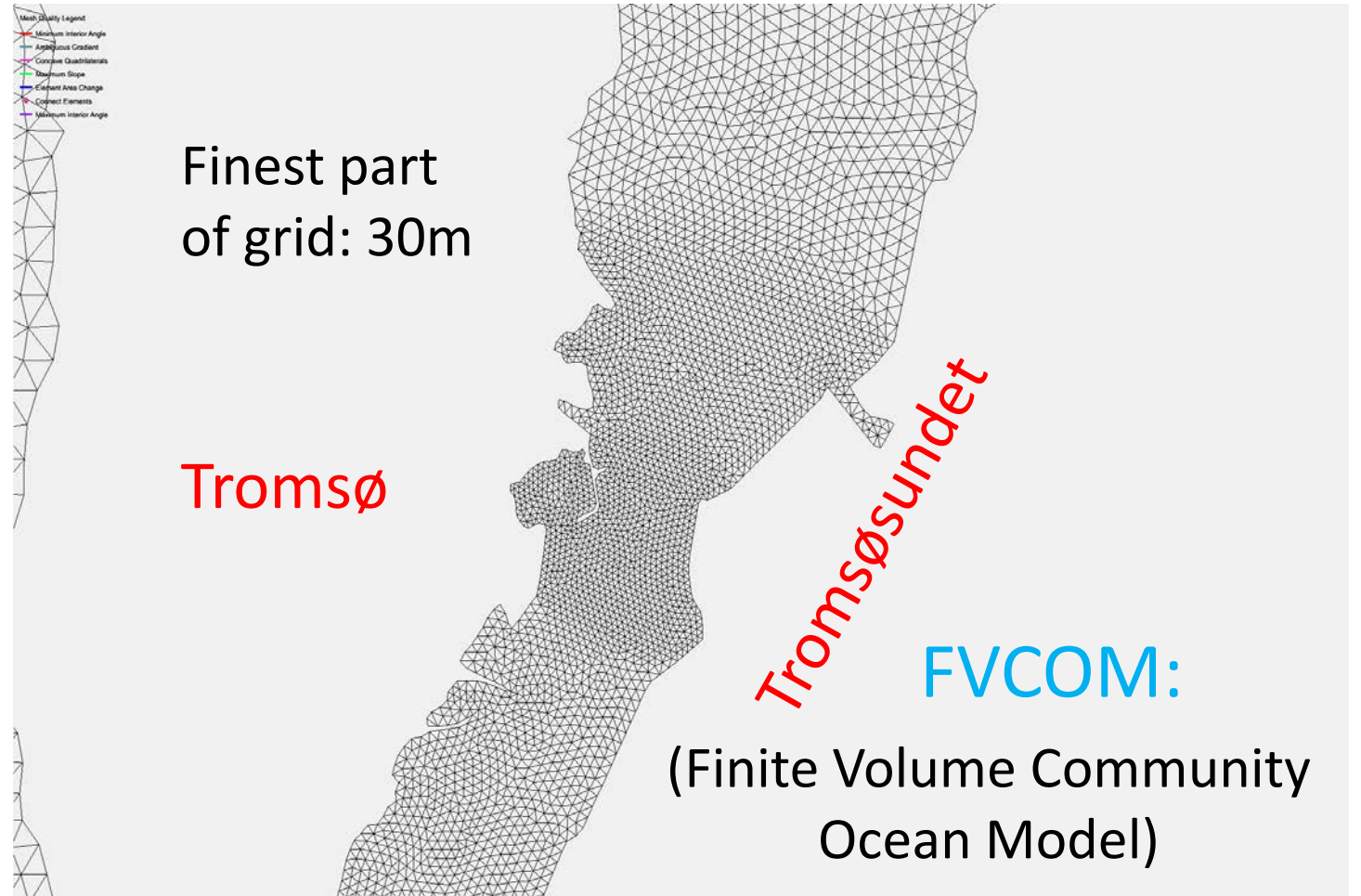
Fig. 4. Two interpretations of the horizontal structure of Saltstraumen.
