Floating License

System requirements

- Microsoft Windows 2000 / XP / Vista (all editions)
- 1 GHz Pentium 4/Althon or better
- 512 MB RAM or more
- 500 MB free disk space

Downloads

The complete WANDA package is available through the Wanda Wiki site: http://wanda.deltares.nl

To get access to the download section you need a wiki-account; the account information has been sent to the Wanda contact known by Deltares.

To install the WANDA program, you need at least the WANDA setup as well as the FlowCharter 2007 setup; WANDA 3.72 uses iGrafx Flowcharter 2007.

To install the license server, you need the license server.zip file from the License manager directory.

In the table below all available downloadable products are listed.

Only for existing WANDA users

It is recommended to uninstall previous versions of Flowcharter and WANDA first (use Start menu/Control panel/remove programs).

Because the uninstall does **NOT** remove the user shape libraries in the directory <code>C:\Documents</code> and <code>Settings\MyUser\Application Data\Wanda 3\Shapelibrary</code>, you have to do this manually This action is necessary because the "Wanda Hydraulic" en "Wanda Control" galleries must be updated with new components. The user shape libraries are only updated if they are empty of non-existing.

On the server, you should remove all Wanda license files.

Install sequence

- Step 0 Download the WANDA setup program WANDA3.72.EXE and Flowcharter FC2007 program from the download site (see wanda wiki).
- Step 1 Install FlowCharter 2007 on the client machine.

The downloaded file is a self-extracting archive. When the program finishes unpacking, start <UnpackDirectory>\setup.exe (usually C:\iGrafx2007\setup.exe).

Depending on your regional settings, the set-up program can ask for the language you want. Always choose the ENGLISH version.

The set up asks for a license key, this code is distributed by Deltares by e-mail. If you forgot this key, the Flowcharter program can only be used for viewing and not for editing (a lock will be visible).

- Step 2 Install WANDA 3.72 on the client machine by executing "Setup Wanda 3.72.exe"
- Step 3 Install the License server (called DS FLEX) on the server machine. Main steps are:
 - Choose in first screen, option "server"
 - Next choose all "default" options
 - Program asks for a license files; this is the Wanda3.lic file (send on request by e-mail).
- Restart the server; license manager will be active now; the following processes Step 4 must be visible in the task manager: Imgrd.exe en dwldelft.exe.
- Step 5 Rename the client.lic file to wanda3.lic and copy the file to the Wanda 3 program directory on the client PC. (default: C:\Program files\Wanda 3\bin).
- Step 6 (only for special components) Copy the gallery "Wanda Special sbj" to C:\Program files\Wanda 3\shapeLibrary" on the client PC.
- Step 7 Reboot the system (if asked for).
- Step 8 Start Wanda.

The user shape galleries will be built, this may take some time. (if this does not occur; a previous version of WANDA was installed before and the existing user shape galleries were not removed before starting this setup)

- consult the on-line help (menu Help/Wanda help...) Step 9 - have a look at the examples
 - (open case from C:\Program files\Wanda 3\Examples) the case "Sewage_transient" highlights the most important Wanda features.

Administrator and user privileges

The set-up utility of WANDA put the files default in the C:\Program Files\Wanda 3 directory. This directory may be read only for the WANDA user. For each user, WANDA creates a user directory in C:\Documents and Settings\MyUser\Application Data\Wanda 3. This creation is done the first time a new user starts WANDA. In this directory all templates and ini-files are located. The original files are stored in the program files directory.

To use WANDA, the user does not need to have any administrator privileges.

Remarks

Save

Save your work regularly using the Save button, menu "File/Save (as)..." or the Ctrl-S key.

iGrafx file

Wanda writes the data to the iGrafx diagram file (extension wdx) and the Wanda input file (extension wdi). The wdi-file contains all hydraulic data and basic graphical data to reproduce the diagram. The wdx-file is the ordinary iGrafx igx-file.

Shape Library

The shape libraries "Wanda Hydraulic All" and "Wanda Control All" contain all available default and license required components. The shape libraries "Wanda Hydraulic" and "Wanda Control" contain all hydraulic and control components to which you are authorised. The user may configure these galleries. If you delete all shapes from these two galleries, the next time you start Wanda these shape libraries are automatically rebuilt. Do not remove shapes from "Wanda Hydraulic All" and "Wanda Control All". If you have ordered a special (custom-made) component, an additional shape gallery "Wanda Special" is part of the delivery package.
