

## 7. Dealing gracefully in OmiEd with 3rd party specialist implimentations

### Summary

Two software providers might choose to provide their own dedicated exchange items and valueset transfer. OpenMI might not recommend this as it reduces interoperability of components. However, if it is the only solution then OpenMI should at least be able to degrade gracefully in its operation.
